Please be advised that the City of New Westminster will be undertaking the removal and replacement of the Tugger Pilot House located at 830 Quayside Drive along the Waterfront Esplanade starting approximately on April 1st 2019. The structure has approached the end of its lifecycle and is in decline due to significant structural corrosion and many years of heavy vandalism.

Staff have collaborated with Contexture Design to develop a design concept (reverse side) for the replacement of the Tugger. The design concept is inspired by a tugboat hauling a large barge loaded with materials, a common sighting along on the Fraser River in New Westminster. The new design will continue to serve as an iconic placemaking feature/ gathering place on the Riverfront, with enhanced play value for children. Project timelines are an estimate.
