

MINUTES

April 24, 2019

Meeting Location: Anchor Pointe Common Room 1135 Quayside Dr.

Guest: Erika Mashig, Parks & Open Space Planning

Erika distributed information on the Quayside Tugger replacement project and reviewed it with the group. She indicated that the structure, originally from Expo '86, was over 30 years old and the metal as well as the boardwalk underneath it were deteriorating. The new project will be playful and safe for children, and the small tugs will be wheelchair accessible. After some discussion, it was felt the removal of Tugger and the replacement of the affected boards should be done now, but the installation of the new play area should wait until the fall when children are back in school.
